- Remedial Massage**
 Goal-oriented form of massage used as a treatment in its own right, or used in conjunction with other fields like physiotherapy and chiropractics to assist in the healing process.
- Sports Massage**
 Branch of sports medicine concerned with the preparation, recovery and maintenance of optimal athletic performance.
- Corporate Massage**
 A unique form of massage used to assist psychological stress and poor ergonomics in the corporate setting.
- Business Management:**
 Understanding best business practices, management and ethical behaviour in the workplace.
